

1810	Edward Morrall opens Liverpool legal practice
1812	Edward Morrall sets up partnership with Richard Radcliffe. Partnership is known as Morrall Radcliffe
1821	Radcliffe joined by George James Duncan. The partnership becomes Radcliffe & Duncan.
1850	Firm known as Duncan Squarey & Duncan
1865	John Edward Gray Hill joins firm which is now known as Duncans Squarey Blackmore Pearson & Hill
1874	John Dickinson joins. Firm becomes Duncan Hill & Dickinson.
1879	Firm becomes Hill & Dickinson

1889	Herbert John Davis founds his own firm - he is the first Jewish solicitor in Liverpool
1892	John Davis and John Clarke form partnership
1904	John E G Hill is knighted
1910	Firm's senior partner, Arthur Norman Hill is knighted for services to the Government. Firm renamed as Hill Dickinson & Co.
1912	Hill Dickinson retained by owners of RMS Titanic to advise them following the vessel's sinking
1927	Miss Edith Berthen joins partnership - one of the first women to qualify as a solicitor
1929	Hill Dickinson & Co establishes a London office
1970	Davis Munro amalgamates with Campbell & Co. to become Davis Campbell

1989	Hill Dickinson merges with Davis Campbell. The firm is renamed Hill Dickinson Davis Campbell.
1990	Hill Dickinson merges with the legal department of the Mersey Regional Health Authority
1998	Hill Dickinson opens offices in Manchester
2001	Hill Dickinson merges with Gorna & Co.
2005	Hill Dickinson merges with Bullivant Jones
2005	Hill Dickinson becomes a limited liability partnership (LLP)
2006	Hill Dickinson merges with Hill Taylor Dickinson
2009	Hill Dickinson opens an office in Singapore
2009	Hill Dickinson merges with Middleton Potts
2010	Hill Dickinson celebrates its 200th anniversary
2010	Hill Dickinson acquires Halliwells Liverpool and parts of Sheffield, extending the firm's office network further across the north.
